When Mary carried Jesus in her womb for nine months and when they made their difficult journey to Bethlehem. Hail Mary...

When Jesus was born in poverty in a cave in Bethlehem and the shepherds and the Magi came to visit him. Hail Mary...

When Mary and Joseph presented their son Jesus in the temple. Hail Mary...

When the Holy Family had to flee to Egypt - to avoid the destruction of the innocent babies - and their return back to Nazareth and when they raised their Son Jesus in the love and fear of God.

When our Lord Jesus was praying and meditating on the Word of God, and he disputed it with the doctors in the temple after he had been without his parents for three days.

When our Lord Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan, who claimed to be the Lamb of God.

When our Lord Jesus was tormented by the devil in the desert for forty days and when he announced that the kingdom of God had arrived and encouraged people to repent.

When our Lord Jesus was praying in secluded places and when he chose twelve disciples

When our Lord Jesus entered the temple, and began to drive out the sellers and buyers, he overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves because they had made his Father's house a house of business.

When our Lord Jesus was asked many questions by the religious leaders of his time who tried to trap him to see if they could catch him in a word. With his answers he would shut their mouths.

When our Lord Jesus wept in Jerusalem, announced the destruction of the temple, the persecution of the disciples and his second coming at the end of time. When the leaders conspired against our him and Judas betrayed him.
